19. David Prayed for Safety

Psalm 35 KJV

Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me. Take <u>hold</u> of shield and <u>buckler</u>, and stand up for mine help.

Draw out also the spear, and stop the way against them that persecute me: say unto my <u>soul</u>, I am thy salvation. Let them be confounded and put to shame that seek after my soul: let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt.

Let them be as <u>chaff</u> before the <u>wind</u>: and let the angel of the LORD chase them ... their way be dark and <u>slippery</u>: and let the angel of the LORD persecute them.

For without cause have they hid for me their net in a pit, which without cause they have <u>digged</u> for my soul. Let destruction come upon him at unawares; and let his net that he hath hid <u>catch</u> himself: into that very destruction let him fall.

And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in his salvation.

All my <u>bones</u> shall say, LORD, who is like unto thee, which deliverest the poor from him that is too strong for him, yea, the poor and the needy from him that <u>spoileth</u> him? <u>False</u> witnesses did rise up; they laid to my charge things ...

They rewarded me evil for good to the spoiling of my soul.

But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was <u>sackcloth</u>: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

I behaved myself as though he had been my friend or brother: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth for his mother. But in mine <u>adversity</u> they rejoiced, and gathered themselves together: yea, the <u>abjects</u> gathered themselves together against me, and I knew it not; they did tear me, and ceased not:

With hypocritical mockers in feasts, they gnashed upon me with their teeth.

Lord, how long wilt thou look on? <u>rescue</u> my soul from their destructions, my <u>darling</u> from the lions. I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people. Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: neither let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause.

For they <u>speak</u> not peace: but they <u>devise deceitful matters</u> against them that are <u>quiet</u> in the land. Yea, they opened their mouth wide against me, and said, Aha, aha, our eye hath seen it. ... O LORD: keep not silence: O Lord, be not far from me. Stir up thyself, and awake to my judgment, even unto my cause, my God and my Lord.

Judge me, O LORD my God, according to thy righteousness; and let them not rejoice over me. Let them not say in their hearts, Ah, so would we have it: let them not say, We have swallowed him up.

Let them be <u>ashamed</u> and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt ... be <u>clothed</u> with shame and <u>dishonour</u> that magnify themselves against me ... shout for <u>joy</u> ... be glad, that favour my righteous cause: ... let them say continually, Let the LORD be <u>magnified</u>, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant. ... my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness ... thy praise all the day long.
