23. Elijah: To Raise The Widow's Son

1 Kings 17:17-24 KJV

And it came to pass after these things, that the son of the woman, the <u>mistress</u> of the <u>house</u>, fell <u>sick</u>; and his sickness was so <u>sore</u>, that there was no breath left in him.

And she said unto <u>Elijah</u>, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son?

And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her <u>bosom</u>, and <u>carried</u> him up into a <u>loft</u>, where he <u>abode</u>, and <u>laid</u> him upon his own bed.

And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also brought evil <u>upon</u> the <u>widow</u> with whom I <u>sojourn</u>, by slaying her son?

And he <u>stretched</u> himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.

And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came into him again, and he <u>revived</u>.

And Elijah took the child, and brought him down out of the <u>chamber</u> into the house, and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, thy son liveth.

And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou art a man of God, and that the word of the LORD in thy mouth is truth.

1 Kings 17:17-24 NIV

Some time later the son of the woman who <u>owned</u> the house became <u>ill</u>. He grew worse and <u>worse</u>, and finally <u>stopped</u> breathing. 18 She said to Elijah, "What do you have against me, man of God? Did you come to <u>remind</u> me of my sin and kill my son?"

"Give me your son," Elijah <u>replied</u>. He took him from her arms, carried him to the <u>upper</u> room where he was staying, and laid him on his bed. Then he cried out to the LORD, "O LORD my God, have you brought tragedy also upon this widow I am staying with, by causing her son to die?" Then he stretched himself out on the boy three times and cried to the LORD, "O LORD my God, let this boy's life <u>return</u> to him!"

The LORD heard Elijah's <u>cry</u>, and the boy's <u>life</u> returned to him, and he lived. Elijah <u>picked</u> up the child and carried him down from the room into the house. He gave him to his mother and said, "Look, your son is alive!"

Then the woman said to Elijah, "Now I know that you are a man of God and that the word of the LORD from your mouth is the <u>truth</u>."
