## 29. Habakkuk: for Revival in Shigionoth

## Habakkuk 3:2-19 KJV

O LORD, I have heard thy <u>speech</u>, and was afraid: O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy. God came from Teman, and the Holy One from mount Paran. Selah. His glory <u>covered</u> the heavens, and the earth was <u>full</u> of his praise. And his brightness was as the light; he had <u>horns</u> coming out of his hand: and there was the <u>hiding</u> of his power.

Before him went the pestilence, and <u>burning</u> coals went forth at his feet. He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the <u>perpetual hills</u> did bow: his ways are everlasting.

I saw the tents of Cushan in affliction: and the <u>curtains</u> of the land of <u>Midian</u> did tremble. Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? was thine anger against the rivers? was thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst <u>ride</u> upon thine <u>horses</u> and thy chariots of salvation?

Thy bow was made quite naked, according to the oaths of the tribes, even thy word. Selah. Thou didst <u>cleave</u> the earth with rivers.

The mountains saw thee, and they trembled: the overflowing of the water passed by: the deep uttered his voice, and lifted up his hands on <u>high</u>. The sun and <u>moon</u> stood still in their habitation: at the light of thine arrows they went, and at the shining of thy glittering <u>spear</u>.

Thou didst march through the land in indignation, thou didst thresh the heathen in anger. Thou wentest forth for the salvation of thy people, even for salvation with thine anointed; thou woundedst the head out of the house of the wicked, by discovering the foundation unto the <u>neck</u>. Selah.

Thou didst strike through with his <u>staves</u> the head of his villages: they came out as a <u>whirlwind</u> to scatter me: their <u>rejoicing</u> was as to <u>devour</u> the poor <u>secretly</u>. Thou didst walk through the sea with thine horses, through the heap of great waters.

When I heard, my belly trembled; my <u>lips quivered</u> at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops.

Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the <u>vines</u>; the labour of the <u>olive</u> shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls: Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.

The LORD God is my strength, and he will make my feet like <u>hinds'</u> feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief <u>singer</u> on my <u>stringed</u> instruments.
