## 32. Hezekiah Prayed for Victory

## 2 Kings 19:9-10, 14-19, 20-22, 34-35 NIV

Now Sennacherib received a <u>report</u> that <u>Tirhakah</u>, the <u>Cushite</u> king of Egypt, was <u>marching</u> out to <u>fight</u> against him. So he again sent messengers to <u>Hezekiah</u> with this word: "Say to Hezekiah king of Judah: Do not let the god you <u>depend</u> on <u>deceive</u> you when he says, 'Jerusalem will not be handed over to the king of <u>Assyria</u>.' ...

Hezekiah received the <u>letter</u> from the messengers and read it. Then he went up to the temple of the LORD and <u>spread</u> it out before the LORD. And Hezekiah prayed to the LORD: "O LORD, God of Israel, enthroned between the <u>cherubim</u>, you alone are God <u>over</u> all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth. Give ear, O LORD, and hear; open your <u>eyes</u>, O LORD, and see; listen to the words Sennacherib has sent to insult the <u>living</u> God.

"It is true, O LORD, that the Assyrian kings have laid <u>waste</u> these nations and their lands. They have thrown their gods into the fire and destroyed them, for they were not gods but only wood and stone, <u>fashioned</u> by men's hands. Now, O LORD our God, deliver us from his hand, so that all kingdoms on earth may know that you <u>alone</u>, O LORD, are God."

Then Isaiah son of Amoz sent a <u>message</u> to Hezekiah: "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I have heard your prayer concerning Sennacherib king of Assyria. This is the word that the LORD has spoken against him:

"'The <u>Virgin</u> Daughter of <u>Zion despises</u> you and <u>mocks</u> you. The Daughter of Jerusalem <u>tosses</u> her head as you <u>flee</u>. Who is it you have <u>insulted</u> and blasphemed?

Against whom have you raised your voice and <u>lifted</u> your eyes in pride? Against the Holy One of Israel! I will defend this city and save it, for my sake and for the sake of David my servant."

That night the angel of the LORD went out and put to death a hundred and <u>eighty</u>-five thousand men in the Assyrian camp. When the people got up the <u>next</u> morning—there were all the dead <u>bodies</u>!
