38. Joshua Prayed for Israel

Joshua 7:6-15 NLT

Joshua and the elders of Israel <u>tore</u> their clothing in <u>dismay</u>, threw <u>dust</u> on their heads, and <u>bowed</u> face down to the <u>ground</u> before the Ark of the Lord until evening. Then Joshua cried out, "Oh, Sovereign Lord, why did you bring us <u>across</u> the <u>Jordan</u> River if you are going to let the <u>Amorites</u> kill us? If only we had been <u>content</u> to stay on the other side! Lord, what can I say now that Israel has fled from its enemies? For when the Canaanites and all the other people living in the land hear about it, they will <u>surround</u> us and <u>wipe</u> our name off the face of the earth. And then what will happen to the honor of your great name?"

But the Lord said to <u>Joshua</u>, "Get up! Why are you <u>lying</u> on your face like this? Israel has sinned and broken my covenant! They have stolen some of the things that I commanded must be set <u>apart</u> for me. And they have not only stolen them but have <u>lied</u> about it and hidden the things among their own belongings. That is why the Israelites are running from their enemies in defeat. For now Israel itself has been set apart for destruction. I will not remain with you any longer <u>unless</u> you destroy the things among you that were set apart for destruction.

"Get up! Command the people to <u>purify</u> themselves in preparation for tomorrow. For this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: <u>Hidden</u> among you, O Israel, are things set apart for the Lord. You will never <u>defeat</u> your enemies until you <u>remove</u> these things from among you.

"In the <u>morning</u> you must <u>present</u> yourselves by <u>tribes</u>, and the Lord will point out the tribe to which the <u>guilty</u> man <u>belongs</u>. That tribe must come <u>forward</u> with its <u>clans</u>, and the Lord will point out the guilty clan. That clan will then come forward, and the Lord will <u>point</u> out the guilty family. Finally, each member of the guilty family must come forward one by one. The one who has stolen what was set apart for destruction will himself be <u>burned</u> with fire, along with everything he has, for he has broken the covenant of the Lord and has done a <u>horrible</u> thing in Israel."
