## 39. Jehoshaphat Seeks Judah's Protection

## 2 Chronicles 20:2-3, 5-12, 17-18, 22, 24 KJV

Then there came some that told Jehoshaphat, saying, There cometh a great multitude against thee from beyond the sea on this side Syria; and, behold, they be in Hazazontamar, which is Engedi.

And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a <u>fast</u> throughout all Judah ... [he] stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new <u>court</u>, And said, O LORD God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? and rulest not thou over all the <u>kingdoms</u> of the <u>heathen</u>? and in thine hand is there not <u>power</u> and might, so that none is <u>able</u> to withstand thee?

Art not thou our God, who didst <u>drive</u> out the inhabitants of this land ... <u>gavest</u> it to the seed of Abraham thy <u>friend</u> for ever? And they <u>dwelt</u> therein, and have built thee a <u>sanctuary</u> therein for thy name, saying,

If, when evil cometh upon us, as the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or <u>famine</u>, we stand before this house, and in thy <u>presence</u>, (for thy name is in this house,) and cry unto thee in our affliction, then thou wilt hear and help ... the children of Ammon and Moab and mount Seir, whom thou wouldest not let Israel <u>invade</u>, when they came out of the land of Egypt, but they turned from them, and destroyed them not;

Behold, I say, how they reward us, to come to cast us out of thy possession, which thou hast given us to <u>inherit</u>. O our God, wilt thou not <u>judge</u> them? for we have no might against this great <u>company</u> that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee...

Ye shall not need to fight in this <u>battle</u>: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.

And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, worshipping the LORD ... when they began to <u>sing</u> and to <u>praise</u>, the LORD set ambushments against the children of <u>Ammon</u>, Moab, and <u>mount Seir</u>, which were come against Judah; and they were <u>smitten</u>.

And when Judah came toward the <u>watch tower</u> in the <u>wilderness</u>, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they were dead <u>bodies</u> fallen to the earth, and none <u>escaped</u>.
