## 4. Abraham Prayed for Abimelech & Wife

## **Genesis 17:1-20 KJV**

... Abraham journeyed ... south <u>country</u>, and dwelled between <u>Kadesh</u> and <u>Shur</u>, and sojourned in Gerar. And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my <u>sister</u>: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

... God came to <u>Abimelech</u> in a dream by <u>night</u>, ... Behold, thou art but a <u>dead</u> man, for the <u>woman</u> which thou hast taken; for she is a man's wife. But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, LORD, wilt thou <u>slay</u> also a righteous nation? Said he not unto me, She is my sister? ... even she herself said, He is my brother: in the <u>integrity</u> of my heart and innocency of my hands ... God said unto him in a <u>dream</u>, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also <u>withheld</u> thee from sinning against me: therefore <u>suffered</u> I thee not to <u>touch</u> her ... <u>restore</u> the man his wife; for he is a prophet, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore her not, know thou that thou shalt <u>surely</u> die, thou, and all that are thine.

... Abimelech <u>rose</u> early in the morning, and called all his servants, and told all these things in their ears: and the men were sore afraid.

Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I <u>offended</u> thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done ... And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the <u>fear</u> of God is not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.

And yet <u>indeed</u> she is my sister; she is the daughter of my father, but not the daughter of my mother; and she became my wife.

And it came to pass, when God caused me to wander from my father's house, that I said unto her, This is thy <u>kindness</u> which thou shalt shew unto me; at every place <u>whither</u> we shall come, say of me, He is my brother.

... Abimelech took sheep, <u>oxen</u>, menservants, womenservants, gave unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife... said, Behold, my land is before thee: dwell where it pleaseth thee ... unto <u>Sarah</u> he said, Behold, I have given thy brother a thousand <u>pieces</u> of <u>silver</u>: behold, he is to thee a <u>covering</u> of the eyes, unto all that are with thee, and with all other: thus she was reproved.

So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they <u>bare</u> children. For the LORD had <u>fast closed</u> up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech, because of Sarah Abraham's wife.
