41. Jeremiah Prayed for God's Patience

Jeremiah 14:7:22 KJV

O LORD, though our iniquities <u>testify</u> against us, do thou it for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against thee. O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a <u>wayfaring</u> man that turneth aside to <u>tarry</u> for a night?

Why shouldest thou be as a man astonied, as a mighty man that cannot save? yet thou, O LORD, art in the <u>midst</u> of us, and we are called by thy name; <u>leave</u> us not.

Thus saith the LORD unto this people, Thus have they <u>loved</u> to <u>wander</u>, they have not <u>refrained</u> their feet, therefore the LORD doth not accept them; he will now remember their iniquity, and <u>visit</u> their sins.

Then said the LORD ... Pray not for this people ... When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and an <u>oblation</u>, I will not accept them ... I will <u>consume</u> them by the sword ... by the famine ... by the pestilence.

Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, the prophets say unto them, Ye shall not <u>see</u> the sword, neither shall ye have famine; but I will give you assured peace in this place.

Then the LORD said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a <u>false vision</u> and divination, and a thing of <u>nought</u>, and the deceit of their heart. Therefore thus <u>saith</u> the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and famine shall not be in this land; By sword and famine shall those prophets be consumed.

And the people to whom they prophesy shall be cast out in the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the <u>sword</u> ... shall have none to <u>bury</u> them ... their wives ... sons, nor their daughters: for I will pour their wickedness upon them.

Therefore thou shalt say this word unto them; Let mine eyes run down with tears night and <u>day</u>, and let them not cease: for the virgin daughter of my people is broken with a great <u>breach</u>, with a very grievous blow.

If I go forth into the field, then behold the slain with the sword! and if I enter into the city, then behold them that are sick with famine! yea, both the prophet and the priest go about into a land that they know not. Hast thou <u>utterly</u> rejected Judah? hath thy soul <u>lothed Zion</u>? why hast thou smitten us, and there is no healing for us? we looked for peace, and there is no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble! We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, and the iniquity of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee. Do not <u>abhor</u> us, for thy name's sake, do not <u>disgrace</u> the <u>throne</u> of thy glory: remember, break not thy covenant with us.

Are there any among the <u>vanities</u> of the <u>Gentiles</u> that can cause rain? or can the heavens give <u>showers</u>? art not thou he, O LORD our God? therefore we will wait upon thee: for thou hast made all these things.
