## 50. Job Responded to the Lord

## Job 42:1-12 AMP

Then <u>Job</u> said to the Lord, I know that You can do all things, and that no thought or purpose of Yours can be restrained or thwarted.

[You said to me] Who is this that <u>darkens</u> and obscures <u>counsel</u> [by words] without knowledge? Therefore [I now see] I have [<u>rashly</u>] <u>uttered</u> what I did not understand, things too wonderful for me, which I did not <u>know</u>.

[I had <u>virtually</u> said to You what You have said to me:] Hear, I <u>beseech</u> You, and I will <u>speak</u>; I will demand of You, and You <u>declare</u> to me. I had heard of You [only] by the hearing of the ear, but now my [<u>spiritual</u>] eye sees You. Therefore I <u>loathe</u> [my words] and <u>abhor</u> myself and <u>repent</u> in dust and <u>ashes</u>.

After the Lord had spoken the previous words to Job, the Lord said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is <u>kindled</u> against you and against your two friends, for you have not spoken of Me the <u>thing</u> that is right, as My servant Job has.

Now therefore take seven bullocks and seven <u>rams</u> and go to My servant Job and <u>offer</u> up for yourselves a burnt offering; and My servant Job shall pray for you, for I will accept [his prayer] that I deal not with you after your <u>folly</u>, in that you have not spoken of Me the thing that is <u>right</u>, as My servant Job has.

So Eliphaz the Temanite and <u>Bildad</u> the Shuhite and Zophar the Naamathite went and did as the Lord commanded them; and the Lord <u>accepted</u> [Job's prayer]. And the Lord turned the <u>captivity</u> of Job and restored his <u>fortunes</u>, when he prayed for his <u>friends</u>; also the Lord gave Job twice as <u>much</u> as he had before.

Then there came to him all his brothers and sisters and all who had known him before, and they <u>ate</u> bread with him in his house; and they sympathized with him and comforted him over all the [distressing] calamities that the Lord had brought upon him. Every man also gave him a <u>piece</u> of money, and every man an <u>earring</u> of gold.

And the Lord blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning.
