51. Jonah for Deliverance from the Whale

Jonah 1:1-7, 12, 17; 2:1-10 KJV

The word of the LORD came to <u>Jonah</u> son of <u>Amittai</u>: "Go to the great city of <u>Nineveh</u> and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me."
