54. Manoah for Guidance for Unborn Child

Judges 13:8-21, 24 KJV

Then <u>Manoah</u> intreated the LORD, and said, O my Lord, let the man of God which thou didst send come again unto us, and <u>teach</u> us what we shall do unto the child that shall be born.

And God hearkened to the voice of Manoah; and the <u>angel</u> of God came again unto the woman as she sat in the <u>field</u>: but Manoah her <u>husband</u> was not with her ... woman made <u>haste</u>, and ran, and shewed her husband ... Behold, the man hath appeared unto me, that came unto me the other day.
