## 58. Moses Prayed for Israel's Forgiveness

## **Deuteronomy 9:16-29 KJV**

... ye had <u>sinned</u> against the LORD your God ... made you a <u>molten calf</u> ... turned <u>aside quickly</u> out of the way which the LORD had commanded you.

And I took the two tables, and cast them out of my two hands, and <u>brake</u> them before your eyes.

And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, <u>forty</u> days and forty nights: I did neither eat <u>bread</u>, nor <u>drink water</u>, because of all your sins which ye sinned, in doing wickedly in the <u>sight</u> of the LORD, to <u>provoke</u> him to anger. For I was <u>afraid</u> of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that <u>time</u> also.

And the LORD was very angry with <u>Aaron</u> to have destroyed him: and I prayed for Aaron also the same time.

And I took your sin, the calf which ye had made, and burnt it with fire, and <u>stamped</u> it, and ground it very small, even until it was as small as dust: and I cast the dust thereof into the brook that descended out of the mount.

And at <u>Taberah</u>, and at Massah, and at Kibrothhattaavah, ye provoked the LORD to <u>wrath</u>. Likewise when the LORD sent you from Kadeshbarnea, saying, Go up and <u>possess</u> the land which I have given you; then ye rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God, and ye believed him not, nor hearkened to his voice.

Ye have been <u>rebellious</u> against the LORD from the day that I knew you. Thus I fell down <u>before</u> the LORD forty days and forty <u>nights</u>, as I fell down at the first; because the LORD had said he would destroy you.

I prayed therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

Remember thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; <u>look</u> not unto the stubbornness of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin:

Lest the land whence thou broughtest us out say, Because the LORD was not able to bring them into the land which he promised them, and because he hated them, he hath brought them out to <u>slay</u> them in the <u>wilderness</u>.

Yet they are thy people and thine inheritance, which thou broughtest out by thy mighty power and by thy <u>stretched</u> out <u>arm</u>.
