## 59. Moses - Face to Face with God

## **Exodus 33:7-23 NIV**

Now Moses used to take a <u>tent</u> and pitch it outside the camp some <u>distance</u> away, calling it the "tent of <u>meeting</u>." Anyone <u>inquiring</u> of the LORD would go to the tent of meeting <u>outside</u> the camp. And whenever Moses went out to the tent, all the people rose and stood at the entrances to their tents, <u>watching</u> Moses until he entered the tent. As Moses went into the tent, the <u>pillar</u> of <u>cloud</u> would come down and stay at the entrance, while the LORD spoke with Moses. Whenever the people saw the pillar of cloud <u>standing</u> at the <u>entrance</u> to the tent, they all stood and worshiped, each at the entrance to his tent. The LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks with his friend. Then Moses would <u>return</u> to the <u>camp</u>, but his <u>young</u> aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent.

Moses said to the LORD, "You have been <u>telling</u> me, 'Lead these people,' but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. You have said, 'I know you by name and you have <u>found favor</u> with me.' If you are pleased with me, <u>teach</u> me your ways so I may know you and <u>continue</u> to find favor with you. <u>Remember</u> that this <u>nation</u> is your people."

...LORD replied, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

Then Moses said to him, "If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here. How will anyone know that you are pleased with me and with your people unless you go with us? What else will distinguish me and your people from all the other people on the face of the earth?"

And the LORD said to Moses, "I will do the very thing you have asked, because I am pleased with you and I know you by name."

Then Moses said, "Now show me your glory."

And the LORD said, "I will cause all my <u>goodness</u> to pass in front of you, and I will <u>proclaim</u> my name, the LORD, in your <u>presence</u>. I will have mercy on <u>whom</u> I will have <u>mercy</u>, and I will have compassion on whom I will have <u>compassion</u>. But," he said, "you cannot see my face, for no one may see me and live."

Then the LORD said, "There is a place near me where you may stand on a rock. When my glory <u>passes</u> by, I will put you in a <u>cleft</u> in the rock and cover you with my hand until I have passed by. Then I will <u>remove</u> my hand and you will see my back; but my face must not be seen."
