Colossians 1:1-18 KJV

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and <u>Timotheus</u> our brother,

To the saints and <u>faithful brethren</u> in Christ which are at <u>Colosse</u>: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying <u>always</u> for you, Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints,

For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the <u>truth</u> of the <u>gospel</u>; Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and <u>bringeth</u> forth fruit, as it doth <u>also</u> in you, since the day ye heard of it, and <u>knew</u> the grace of God in truth:

As ye also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a faithful <u>minister</u> of Christ;

Who also <u>declared</u> unto us your love in the Spirit.

For this <u>cause</u> we <u>also</u>, since the day we heard it, do not <u>cease</u> to pray for you, and to <u>desire</u> that ye might be <u>filled</u> with the knowledge of his <u>will</u> in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

That ye might <u>walk worthy</u> of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in <u>every</u> good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Strengthened with all might, according to his <u>glorious</u> power, unto all <u>patience</u> and longsuffering with joyfulness; Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of <u>darkness</u>, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his <u>dear</u> Son: In <u>whom</u> we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, <u>visible</u> and invisible, whether they be <u>thrones</u>, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the <u>firstborn</u> from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.
