77. Solomon Dedicates the Temple, Part I

2 Chronicles 6:12-27 KJV

And he stood before the altar of the LORD in the presence of all the congregation of Israel, and <u>spread</u> forth his hands: For Solomon had made a <u>brasen</u> <u>scaffold</u> of five <u>cubits</u> long, and five cubits <u>broad</u>, and three cubits high, and had set it in the midst of the <u>court</u>: and upon it he stood, and kneeled down upon his <u>knees</u> before all the <u>congregation</u> of Israel ... said, O LORD God of Israel, there is no God like thee in the heaven, nor in the earth; which keepest covenant, and shewest <u>mercy</u> unto thy servants, that walk before thee with all their hearts: Thou which hast kept with thy servant David my father that which thou hast promised him; and spakest with thy mouth, and hast <u>fulfilled</u> it with thine hand, as it is this day.

Now therefore, O LORD God of Israel, keep with thy servant David my father that which thou hast promised him, saying, There shall not <u>fail</u> thee a man in my <u>sight</u> to sit upon the throne of Israel; yet so that thy children take <u>heed</u> to their way to walk in my law, as thou hast walked before me ... let thy word be <u>verified</u>, which thou hast <u>spoken</u> unto thy servant David.

But will God in very deed dwell with men on the earth? behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot <u>contain</u> thee; how much <u>less</u> this house which I have built!

Have respect therefore to the prayer of thy servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the <u>cry</u> and the prayer which thy servant prayeth before thee: That thine eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the <u>place</u> whereof thou hast said that thou wouldest put thy name there; to <u>hearken</u> unto the prayer which thy servant prayeth toward this place.

Hearken therefore unto the supplications of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear thou from thy dwelling place, even from heaven; and when thou hearest, forgive. If a man sin against his <u>neighbour</u>, and an oath be laid upon him to make him <u>swear</u>, and the <u>oath</u> come before thine altar in this <u>house</u>; Then hear thou from heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, by <u>requiting</u> the wicked, by <u>recompensing</u> his way upon his own head; and by justifying the righteous, by giving him according to his righteousness.

And if thy people Israel be put to the worse before the enemy, because they have <u>sinned</u> against thee; and shall return and confess thy name, and pray and make supplication before thee in this house; Then hear thou from the heavens, and forgive the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them <u>again</u> unto the land which thou gavest to them and to their fathers. When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; yet if they pray <u>toward</u> this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them; Then hear thou from heaven, and forgive the sin of thy servants, and of thy people Israel, when thou hast <u>taught</u> them the good way, wherein they should walk; and send rain upon thy land, which thou hast given unto thy people for an inheritance.
