14. Disobey and You Will Be Cursed, Pt. 2

Deuteronomy 28:30-44 KJV

Thou shalt <u>betroth</u> a <u>wife</u>, and another man shall lie with her: thou shalt build an <u>house</u>, and thou shalt not dwell therein: thou shalt plant a <u>vineyard</u>, and shalt not <u>gather</u> the <u>grapes</u> thereof.

Thine ox shall be slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass shall be violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be <u>restored</u> to thee: thy sheep shall be given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to <u>rescue</u> them.

Thy sons and thy <u>daughters</u> shall be given unto another people, and thine eyes shall look, and <u>fail</u> with <u>longing</u> for them all the day long; and there shall be no might in thine hand.

The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only <u>oppressed</u> and <u>crushed</u> alway: So that thou shalt be mad for the <u>sight</u> of thine eyes which thou shalt see.

The LORD shall smite thee in the <u>knees</u>, and in the <u>legs</u>, with a sore botch that cannot be healed, from the sole of thy <u>foot</u> unto the top of thy head.

The LORD shall bring thee, and thy king which thou shalt set over thee, unto a nation which neither thou nor thy fathers have known; and there shalt thou serve other gods, wood and stone.

And thou shalt become an <u>astonishment</u>, a <u>proverb</u>, and a <u>byword</u>, among all nations whither the LORD shall lead thee.

Thou shalt carry much seed out into the field, and shalt gather but little in; for the <u>locust</u> shall <u>consume</u> it.

Thou shalt plant vineyards, and <u>dress</u> them, but shalt neither <u>drink</u> of the wine, nor gather the grapes; for the <u>worms</u> shall eat them.

Thou shalt have olive trees throughout all thy <u>coasts</u>, but thou shalt not anoint thyself with the oil; for thine <u>olive</u> shall cast his fruit.

Thou shalt beget sons and daughters, but thou shalt not <u>enjoy</u> them; for they shall go into <u>captivity</u>.

All thy trees and fruit of thy land shall the locust consume.

The <u>stranger</u> that is within thee shall get up above thee very high; and thou shalt come down very low. He shall lend to thee, and thou shalt not lend to him: he shall be the head, and thou shalt be the tail.
