15. Disobey and You Will Be Cursed, Pt. 3

Deuteronomy 28:45-55 KJV

Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall <u>pursue</u> thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou <u>hearkenedst</u> not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to <u>keep</u> his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee:

And they shall be upon thee for a <u>sign</u> and for a <u>wonder</u>, and upon thy seed for ever.

Because thou servedst not the LORD thy God with <u>joyfulness</u>, and with <u>gladness</u> of heart, for the <u>abundance</u> of all things;

Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the LORD shall send against thee, in <u>hunger</u>, and in <u>thirst</u>, and in <u>nakedness</u>, and in want of all things: and he shall put a <u>yoke</u> of <u>iron</u> upon thy <u>neck</u>, until he have destroyed thee.

The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the <u>end</u> of the earth, as <u>swift</u> as the <u>eagle</u> flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand; A nation of <u>fierce countenance</u>, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor shew favour to the <u>young</u>:

And he shall eat the fruit of thy <u>cattle</u>, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which also shall not leave thee either corn, wine, or oil, or the increase of thy <u>kine</u>, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

And he shall <u>besiege</u> thee in all thy gates, until thy high and <u>fenced walls</u> come down, wherein thou trustedst, throughout all thy land: and he shall besiege thee in all thy gates throughout all thy land, which the LORD thy God hath given thee.

And thou shalt eat the fruit of thine own <u>body</u>, the flesh of thy sons and of thy daughters, which the LORD thy God hath given thee, in the siege, and in the <u>straitness</u>, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee:

So that the man that is <u>tender</u> among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his <u>brother</u>, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

So that he will not give to any of them of the flesh of his children whom he shall eat: because he hath nothing left him in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee in all thy gates.
