16. Disobey and You Will Be Cursed, Pt. 4

Deuteronomy 28:56-68 KJV

The tender and <u>delicate</u> woman among you, which would not <u>adventure</u> to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the <u>husband</u> of her <u>bosom</u>, and toward her son, and toward her daughter ... her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: for she shall eat them for want of all things secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.

If thou wilt not <u>observe</u> to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this <u>glorious</u> and <u>fearful</u> name, THE LORD THY GOD; Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy <u>seed</u>, even great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance.

Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall <u>cleave</u> unto thee. Also every <u>sickness</u>, and every <u>plague</u>, which is not written in the book of this law, them will the LORD bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed. And ye shall be left few in <u>number</u>, whereas ye were as the <u>stars</u> of heaven for <u>multitude</u>; because thou wouldest not obey the <u>voice</u> of the LORD thy God.

And it shall come to pass, that as the LORD rejoiced over you to do you good, and to <u>multiply</u> you; so the LORD will rejoice over you to destroy you, and to bring you to nought; and ye shall be <u>plucked</u> from off the land whither thou goest to possess it. And the LORD shall <u>scatter</u> thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other gods, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, even wood and stone. And among these nations shalt thou find no ease, neither shall the sole of thy foot have rest: but the LORD shall give thee there a <u>trembling</u> heart, and <u>failing</u> of <u>eyes</u>, and <u>sorrow</u> of <u>mind</u>: And thy life shall hang in <u>doubt</u> before thee; and thou shalt fear day and night, and shalt have none <u>assurance</u> of thy life: In the morning thou shalt say, Would God it were even! and at even thou shalt say, Would God it were <u>morning</u>! for the fear of thine heart wherewith thou shalt fear, and for the sight of thine eyes which thou shalt see.

And the LORD shall bring thee into <u>Egypt</u> again with <u>ships</u>, by the way whereof I spake unto thee, Thou shalt see it no more again: and there ye shall be sold unto your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen, and no man shall buy you.
