27. Righteousness Through Faith

Romans 4:18-24 NIV

Against all <u>hope</u>, <u>Abraham</u> in hope <u>believed</u> and so <u>became</u> the <u>father</u> of <u>many nations</u>, just as it had <u>been</u> said to him, "So shall your <u>offspring</u> be." <u>Without weakening</u> in his faith, he <u>faced</u> the fact that his <u>body</u> was as <u>good</u> as <u>dead</u>—<u>since</u> he was about a <u>hundred</u> years old—and that Sarah's womb was also dead.

Yet he did not <u>waver</u> through <u>unbelief regarding</u> the <u>promise</u> of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave <u>glory</u> to God, being <u>fully persuaded</u> that God had power to do what he had promised. This is why "it was <u>credited</u> to him as righteousness." The words "it was credited to him" were <u>written</u> not for him <u>alone</u>, but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in him who <u>raised</u> Jesus our Lord from the dead.
