Wherefore <u>seeing</u> we also are <u>compassed</u> about with so <u>great</u> a cloud of <u>witnesses</u>, let us lay <u>aside every weight</u>, and the sin which <u>doth</u> so <u>easily beset</u> us, and let us run with <u>patience</u> the race that is set before us,

Looking unto Jesus the <u>author</u> and <u>finisher</u> of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him <u>endured</u> the cross, <u>despising</u> the <u>shame</u>, and is set down at the right hand of the <u>throne</u> of God.

For consider him that endured such contradiction of <u>sinners</u> against himself, lest ye be <u>wearied</u> and <u>faint</u> in your minds.

Romans 10:13-17 KJV

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not <u>heard</u>? and how shall they hear without a <u>preacher</u>?

And how shall they preach, except they be <u>sent</u>? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the <u>gospel</u> of peace, and bring <u>glad tidings</u> of good things!

But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For <u>Esaias</u> saith, Lord, who hath believed our <u>report</u>?

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
