

71. The Power of Praise

Psalm 8:2 NIV

From the lips of children and infants, you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.

2 Chronicles 20:18-22 NIV

Jehoshaphat bowed with his face to the ground, and all the people of Judah and Jerusalem fell down in worship before the LORD. Then some Levites from the Kohathites and Korahites stood up and praised the LORD ... with very loud voice.

Early in the morning they left for the Desert of Tekoa. ... Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Listen to me ... Have faith in the LORD your God and you will be upheld; have faith in his prophets and you will be successful." ... Jehoshaphat appointed men to sing to the LORD and to praise him for the splendor of his holiness as they went out at the head of the army, saying:

"Give thanks to the LORD, for his love endures forever."

As they began to sing and praise, the LORD set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated.

Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us.

And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.
