76. God Disciplines His Sons

Hebrews 12:1-13 NIV

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so <u>easily entangles</u>, and let us run with perseverance the <u>race marked</u> out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, <u>scorning</u> its <u>shame</u>, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured such opposition from <u>sinful</u> men, so that you will not <u>grow weary</u> and lose heart.

In your <u>struggle</u> against sin, you have not yet <u>resisted</u> to the point of shedding your blood. And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that <u>addresses</u> you as sons:

"My son, do not make <u>light</u> of the Lord's discipline, and do not <u>lose</u> heart when he <u>rebukes</u> you, because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he <u>punishes</u> everyone he accepts as a son."

Endure <u>hardship</u> as discipline; God is <u>treating</u> you as sons. For what son is not disciplined by his father? If you are not disciplined (and everyone <u>undergoes</u> discipline), then you are illegitimate children and not true sons. Moreover, we have all had <u>human</u> fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of our spirits and live! Our fathers disciplined us for a little while as they thought <u>best</u>; but God disciplines us for our <u>good</u>, that we may <u>share</u> in his <u>holiness</u>. No discipline seems <u>pleasant</u> at the time, but <u>painful</u>. Later on, however, it produces a <u>harvest</u> of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

Therefore, strengthen your feeble <u>arms</u> and weak knees. "Make level <u>paths</u> for your feet," so that the lame may not be disabled, but <u>rather</u> healed.
