15. Talents (Ten Servants)

Luke 19:11-27

The <u>crowd</u> was still <u>listening</u> to Jesus as he was getting <u>close</u> to Jerusalem. Many of them thought that God's kingdom would soon <u>appear</u>, and Jesus told them this <u>story</u>:

A <u>prince</u> once went to a <u>foreign</u> country to be <u>crowned</u> king and then to return. But before leaving, he called in ten servants and gave each of them some <u>money</u>. He told them, "Use this to earn more money until I get <u>back</u>."

But the people of his country <u>hated</u> him, and they sent <u>messengers</u> to the foreign country to say, "We don't want this man to be our king."
