2. The Parable of the Sower

Mark 4:1-20

And he began again to <u>teach</u> by the <u>sea</u> side: and there was <u>gathered</u> unto him a great <u>multitude</u>, so that he entered into a <u>ship</u>, and sat in the sea; and the <u>whole</u> multitude was by the sea on the land. And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his <u>doctrine</u>,

Hearken; Behold, there went out a sower to sow:

And it came to pass, as he sowed, some fell by the way side, and the <u>fowls</u> of the air came and devoured it up.

And some fell on <u>stony ground</u>, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth: But when the <u>sun</u> was up, it was <u>scorched</u>; and because it had no root, it withered away.

And some fell among <u>thorns</u>, and the thorns grew up, and <u>choked</u> it, and it yielded no fruit.

And other fell on good ground, and did yield <u>fruit</u> that <u>sprang</u> up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred. And he said unto them, He that hath <u>ears</u> to hear, let him hear.

And when he was alone, they that were about him with the <u>twelve</u> asked of him the parable. And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the <u>mystery</u> of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are <u>done</u> in parables: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be <u>converted</u>, and their sins should be forgiven them.

And he said unto them, KNOW YE NOT THIS <u>PARABLE</u>? AND HOW THEN WILL YE KNOW ALL PARABLES? (emphasis added)

The sower soweth the word.

And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with <u>gladness</u>;

And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when <u>affliction</u> or persecution ariseth for the word's <u>sake</u>, immediately they are offended.

And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the word,

And the cares of this world, and the <u>deceitfulness</u> of riches, and the <u>lusts</u> of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

And these are they which are <u>sown</u> on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some <u>sixty</u>, and some an hundred.
