Then <u>someone</u> called from the crowd, "Teacher, please tell my brother to <u>divide</u> our father's <u>estate</u> with me."

Jesus replied, "Friend, who made me a judge over you to decide such things as that?" Then he said, "<u>Beware! Guard against</u> every kind of greed. Life is not <u>measured</u> by how much you <u>own</u>."

Then he told them a <u>story</u>: "A <u>rich</u> man had a <u>fertile farm</u> that <u>produced fine crops</u>. He said to himself, 'What should I do? I don't have room for all my crops.' Then he said, 'I know! I'll tear <u>down</u> my <u>barns</u> and build <u>bigger</u> ones. Then I'll have room enough to store all my <u>wheat</u> and other goods. And I'll sit <u>back</u> and say to myself, "My friend, you have enough stored away for years to come. Now take it <u>easy</u>! Eat, <u>drink</u>, and be <u>merry</u>!""
