24. The Prodigal Son

Luke 15:11-32 NASB

Jesus also told them another story: Once a man had two sons. The younger son said to his father, "Give me my <u>share</u> of the <u>property</u>." So the father <u>divided</u> his property between his two sons.

Not long after that, the younger son packed up everything he owned and left for a foreign country, where he <u>wasted</u> all his money in wild living. He had spent everything, when a bad famine <u>spread</u> through that whole land. Soon he had nothing to eat. He went to work for a man in that country, and the man sent him out to take care of his pigs. He would have been glad to eat what the pigs were <u>eating</u>, but no one gave him a thing. Finally, he came to his <u>senses</u> and said, "My father's workers have plenty to eat, and here I am, <u>starving</u> to death! I will go to my father and say to him, `Father, I have sinned against God in heaven and <u>against</u> you. I am no <u>longer</u> good enough to be called your son. Treat me like one of your workers.' "

The <u>younger</u> son got up and started back to his father. But when he was still a long way off, his father saw him and felt <u>sorry</u> for him. He ran to his son and <u>hugged</u> and <u>kissed</u> him.

The son said, "Father, I have <u>sinned</u> against God in heaven and against you. I am no longer good enough to be called your son."

But his father said to the servants, "Hurry and bring the best <u>clothes</u> and put them on him. Give him a <u>ring</u> for his <u>finger</u> and <u>sandals</u> for his feet. And they began to celebrate. The older son had been out in the field. But when he came near the house, he heard the <u>music</u> and <u>dancing</u>. So he called one of the servants over and asked, "What's going on here?"

The servant answered, "Your brother has come home safe and sound, and your father ordered us to <u>kill</u> the best calf." The older brother got so angry that he would not even go into the house. His father came out and begged him to go in. But he said to his father, "For years I have worked for you like a <u>slave</u> and have always obeyed you. But you have never even given me a little <u>goat</u>, so that I could give a <u>dinner</u> for my friends. This other son of yours wasted your money on prostitutes. And now that he has come home, you <u>ordered</u> the best <u>calf</u> to be killed for a feast."
