Luke 18:9-14 AMP

And He also told this parable to some people who <u>trusted</u> in <u>themselves</u> that they were <u>righteous</u>, and <u>viewed</u> others with <u>contempt</u>:

"<u>Two men</u> went up into the <u>temple</u> to pray, one a <u>Pharisee</u> and the other a <u>tax collector</u>.

"The Pharisee stood and was praying this to <u>himself</u>: 'God, I thank You that I am not like other people: <u>swindlers</u>, <u>unjust</u>, <u>adulterers</u>, or even like this tax collector.

'I fast twice a week; I pay tithes of all that I get.'

"But the tax collector, standing some <u>distance</u> away, was <u>even</u> <u>unwilling</u> to <u>lift</u> up his <u>eyes</u> to <u>heaven</u>, but was <u>beating</u> his <u>breast</u>, saying, 'God, be <u>merciful</u> to me, the sinner!'

"I tell you, this man went to his house justified <u>rather</u> than the other; for everyone who <u>exalts</u> himself will be humbled, but he who <u>humbles</u> himself will be exalted."
