Mark 4:26-29 NIV

He also said, "This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. All by itself the soil produces grain—first the stalk, then the head, then the full kernel in the head. As soon as the grain is ripe, he puts the sickle to it, because the harvest has come."

And He was saying, "The kingdom of God is like a man who <u>casts</u> seed upon the <u>soil</u>; and he goes to <u>bed</u> at <u>night</u> and <u>gets</u> up by day, and the seed <u>sprouts</u> and grows--how, he himself does not <u>know</u>.

"The soil <u>produces crops</u> by itself; first the <u>blade</u>, then the head, then the mature grain in the head.

"But when the crop <u>permits</u>, he <u>immediately</u> puts in the <u>sickle</u>, because the <u>harvest</u> has come."
