35. Count the Cost (Cost of Being a Disciple, Building a Tower)

Luke 14:25-35 NLT

A <u>large crowd</u> was <u>following</u> Jesus. He <u>turned around</u> and said to them, "If you want to be my disciple, you <u>must hate everyone else</u> by <u>comparison</u>—your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even your own life. Otherwise, you <u>cannot</u> be my <u>disciple</u>. And if you do not <u>carry</u> your own <u>cross</u> and follow me, you cannot be my disciple.

"But don't begin until you <u>count</u> the <u>cost</u>. For who would begin <u>construction</u> of a <u>building</u> without first <u>calculating</u> the cost to see if there is enough money to <u>finish</u> it? Otherwise, you might complete only the foundation before running out of money, and then everyone would <u>laugh</u> at you. They would say, 'There's the person who <u>started</u> that building and couldn't afford to finish it!'

"Or what king would go to war against another king without first sitting down with his counselors to discuss whether his army of 10,000 could defeat the 20,000 soldiers marching against him? And if he can't, he will send a delegation to discuss terms of peace while the enemy is still far away. So you cannot become my disciple without giving up everything you own.

"Salt is good for seasoning. But if it loses its <u>flavor</u>, how do you make it <u>salty</u> again? Flavorless salt is good neither for the soil nor for the <u>manure pile</u>. It is thrown away. Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand!"
