36. Do Not Worry (Bird & Lilies)

Matthew 6:24-33 NIV

"Therefore I tell you, do not <u>worry</u> about your <u>life</u>, what you will <u>eat</u> or drink; or about your <u>body</u>, what you will <u>wear</u>. Is not life more important than <u>food</u>, and the body more <u>important</u> than <u>clothes</u>? Look at the <u>birds</u> of the <u>air</u>; they do not <u>sow</u> or <u>reap</u> or <u>store</u> away in <u>barns</u>, and yet your heavenly Father <u>feeds</u> them. Are you not much more <u>valuable</u> than they? Who of you by worrying can add a <u>single</u> hour to his life?

"And why do you worry about clothes? See how the <u>lilies</u> of the field grow. They do not <u>labor</u> or <u>spin</u>. Yet I tell you that not even <u>Solomon</u> in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the <u>grass</u> of the <u>field</u>, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the <u>pagans run</u> after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But <u>seek</u> first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these <u>things</u> will be given to you as well. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about <u>itself</u>. Each day has <u>enough</u> trouble of its own.
