Luke 11:24-26 KJV

When the <u>unclean spirit</u> is <u>gone</u> out of a man, he walketh through <u>dry</u> places, seeking <u>rest</u>; and finding <u>none</u>, he saith, I will <u>return</u> unto my house <u>whence</u> I <u>came</u> out.

And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished.

Then goeth he, and taketh to him <u>seven</u> other spirits more <u>wicked</u> than <u>himself</u>; and they <u>enter</u> in, and <u>dwell</u> there: and the <u>last state</u> of that man is worse than the first.

Luke 11:24-26 CEV

When an evil spirit <u>leaves</u> a <u>person</u>, it <u>travels</u> through the <u>desert</u>, <u>looking</u> for a place to rest. But when it doesn't find a <u>place</u>, it says, "I will go <u>back</u> to the home I left." When it gets there and finds the place clean and <u>fixed</u> up, it goes off and finds seven other evil spirits even worse than <u>itself</u>. They all come and make their home there, and that person ends up in worse <u>shape</u> than <u>before</u>.
