## 50. The Sheep and Goats (Final Judgment)

## Matthew 25:31-46 NTL

"But when the Son of Man comes in his <u>glory</u>, and all the angels with him, then he will sit upon his glorious <u>throne</u>. All the <u>nations</u> will be <u>gathered</u> in his <u>presence</u>, and he will <u>separate</u> the people as a shepherd separates the <u>sheep</u> from the <u>goats</u>. He will place the sheep at his right hand and the goats at his left.

"Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are <u>blessed</u> by my Father, <u>inherit</u> the Kingdom prepared for you from the <u>creation</u> of the world. For I was <u>hungry</u>, and you fed me. I was <u>thirsty</u>, and you gave me a <u>drink</u>. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. I was <u>naked</u>, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.'

"Then these righteous ones will reply, 'Lord, when did we ever see you hungry and <u>feed</u> you? Or thirsty and give you something to drink? Or a stranger and show you <u>hospitality</u>? Or naked and give you clothing? When did we ever see you sick or in prison and visit you?"

"And the King will say, 'I tell you the truth, when you did it to one of the <u>least</u> of these my brothers and sisters, you were doing it to me!'

"Then the King will turn to those on the left and say, 'Away with you, you <u>cursed</u> ones, into the eternal <u>fire</u> prepared for the <u>devil</u> and his <u>demons</u>. For I was hungry, and you didn't feed me. I was thirsty, and you didn't give me a drink. I was a <u>stranger</u>, and you didn't <u>invite</u> me into your home. I was naked, and you didn't give me clothing. I was sick and in prison, and you didn't visit me.'

"Then they will reply, 'Lord, when did we ever see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or <u>sick</u> or in <u>prison</u>, and not help you?"

"And he will answer, 'I tell you the truth, when you <u>refused</u> to help the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were refusing to <u>help</u> me.'

"And they will go away into eternal <u>punishment</u>, but the righteous will go into <u>eternal</u> life."
