## 66. Good Figs and Bad Figs

## Jeremiah 24:1-10 NLT

After King Nebuchadnezzar of <u>Babylon</u> exiled Jehoiachin son of Jehoiakim, king of Judah, to Babylon along with the <u>officials</u> of Judah and all the <u>craftsmen</u> and <u>artisans</u>, the Lord gave me this <u>vision</u>. I saw two baskets of figs placed in front of the Lord's Temple in Jerusalem. One <u>basket</u> was filled with <u>fresh</u>, <u>ripe figs</u>, while the other was filled with bad figs that were too <u>rotten</u> to eat.

Then the Lord said to me, "What do you see, Jeremiah?"

I <u>replied</u>, "Figs, some very good and some very bad, too rotten to eat."

Then the Lord gave me this <u>message</u>: "This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: The good figs represent the <u>exiles</u> I sent from Judah to the land of the Babylonians. I will watch over and care for them, and I will <u>bring</u> them back here again. I will build them up and not tear them down. I will plant them and not uproot them. I will give them hearts that <u>recognize</u> me as the Lord. They will be my people, and I will be their God, for they will return to me <u>wholeheartedly</u>.

"But the bad figs," the Lord said, "represent King Zedekiah of Judah, his officials, all the people left in Jerusalem, and those who live in Egypt. I will treat them like bad figs, too rotten to eat. I will make them an object of horror and a symbol of evil to every nation on earth. They will be disgraced and mocked, taunted and cursed, wherever I scatter them. And I will send war, famine, and disease until they have vanished from the land of Israel, which I gave to them and their ancestors."
