## 76. The River of Healing (Rising Water from the Temple)

## Ezekiel 47:1-

In my <u>vision</u>, the man brought me back to the <u>entrance</u> of the Temple. There I saw a stream flowing east from beneath the door of the Temple and <u>passing</u> to the right of the <u>altar</u> on its <u>south</u> side. The man brought me outside the wall through the north gateway and led me around to the eastern entrance. There I could see the water flowing out through the south side of the <u>east gateway</u>.

Measuring as he went, he took me along the <u>stream</u> for 1,750 feet and then led me <u>across</u>. The water was up to my <u>ankles</u>. He measured off another 1,750 feet and led me across again. This time the water was up to my <u>knees</u>. After another 1,750 feet, it was up to my waist. Then he measured <u>another</u> 1,750 feet, and the river was too deep to walk across. It was deep enough to <u>swim</u> in, but too deep to <u>walk</u> through.

He asked me, "Have you been watching, son of man?" Then he led me back along the riverbank. When I returned, I was surprised by the sight of many trees growing on both sides of the river. Then he said to me, "This river flows east through the desert into the valley of the Dead Sea. The waters of this stream will make the salty waters of the Dead Sea fresh and pure. here will be swarms of living things wherever the water of this river flows. Fish will abound in the Dead Sea, for its waters will become fresh. Life will flourish wherever this water flows. Fishermen will stand along the shores of the Dead Sea. All the way from En-gedi to En-eglaim, the shores will be covered with nets drying in the sun. Fish of every kind will fill the Dead Sea, just as they fill the Mediterranean. But the marshes and swamps will not be purified; they will still be salty. Fruit trees of all kinds will grow along both sides of the river. The leaves of these trees will never turn brown and fall, and there will always be fruit on their branches. There will be a new crop every month, for they are watered by the river flowing from the Temple. The fruit will be for food and the leaves for healing."
