1. And On the Third Day

Mark 16:1-20 NIV

When the <u>Sabbath</u> was over, Mary Magdalene, <u>Mary</u> the mother of James, and Salome bought <u>spices</u> so that they might go to <u>anoint</u> Jesus' body. Very early on the first day of the week, just after <u>sunrise</u>, they were on their way to the <u>tomb</u> and they asked each other, "Who will roll the <u>stone</u> away from the entrance of the tomb?"

But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been <u>rolled</u> away. As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were <u>alarmed</u>.

"Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for <u>Jesus</u> the Nazarene, who was <u>crucified</u>. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and <u>Peter</u>, 'He is going ahead of you into <u>Galilee</u>. There you will see him, just as he told you.' "

Trembling and <u>bewildered</u>, the women went out and <u>fled</u> from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid.

When Jesus <u>rose</u> early on the first day of the week, he appeared <u>first</u> to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had driven seven demons. She went and told those who had been with him and who were mourning and <u>weeping</u>. When they heard that Jesus was alive and that she had seen him, they did not believe it.

Afterward Jesus appeared in a different form to two of them while they were walking in the country. These returned and reported it to the rest; but they did not believe them either.

Later Jesus appeared to the Eleven as they were eating; he rebuked them for their <u>lack</u> of <u>faith</u> and their stubborn <u>refusal</u> to believe those who had seen him after he had risen. He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the <u>good news</u> to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be <u>saved</u>, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will <u>drive</u> out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will <u>pick</u> up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not <u>hurt</u> them at all; they will place their <u>hands</u> on <u>sick</u> people, and they will get well."

After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God. Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his <u>word</u> by the signs that accompanied it.
