10. Jailor and Family Were Saved

Acts 16:16-33 KJV

And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a <u>certain damsel</u> possessed with a spirit of <u>divination</u> met us, which brought her <u>masters</u> much gain by <u>soothsaying</u>: The same followed <u>Paul</u> and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

And this did she many days. But Paul, being <u>grieved</u>, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the <u>same hour</u>.

And when her masters saw that the <u>hope</u> of their gains was <u>gone</u>, they caught Paul and <u>Silas</u>, and <u>drew</u> them into the <u>marketplace</u> unto the rulers, And brought them to the magistrates, saying, These men, being Jews, do exceedingly trouble our <u>city</u>, And teach <u>customs</u>, which are not <u>lawful</u> for us to receive, neither to observe, being Romans.

And the multitude rose up together against them: and the magistrates rent off their clothes, and commanded to beat them.

And when they had laid many <u>stripes</u> upon them, they cast them into prison, charging the <u>jailor</u> to keep them safely:

Who, having received such a charge, <u>thrust</u> them into the <u>inner</u> prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks.

And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and <u>sang</u> praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the <u>doors</u> were opened, and every one's bands were loosed. And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his <u>sword</u>, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

But Paul cried with a <u>loud</u> voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here.

Then he called for a light, and <u>sprang</u> in, and came trembling, and fell <u>down</u> before Paul and Silas, And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved?

And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.
