2. Israelites Crossed the Red Sea

Exodus 14:1-18 KJV

And the LORD spake unto <u>Moses</u>, saying, Speak unto the children of <u>Israel</u>, that they <u>turn</u> and <u>encamp</u> before Pihahiroth, between Migdol and the <u>sea</u>, over against Baalzephon: before it shall ye encamp by the sea. For <u>Pharaoh</u> will say of the children of Israel, They are entangled in the land, the wilderness hath shut them in.

And I will <u>harden</u> Pharaoh's <u>heart</u>, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD. And they did so.

And it was told the king of Egypt that the people fled: and the heart of Pharaoh and of his servants was turned against the people, and they said, Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us? And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their <u>eyes</u>, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD.

And they said unto Moses, Because there were no graves in Egypt, hast thou taken us away to die in the wilderness? wherefore hast thou dealt thus with us, to carry us forth out of Egypt? Is not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For it had been better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, <u>stand still</u>, and see the <u>salvation</u> of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

The LORD shall <u>fight</u> for you, and ye shall <u>hold</u> your <u>peace</u>.

And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: But <u>lift</u> thou up thy <u>rod</u>, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and <u>divide</u> it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea. And I, behold, I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them: and I will get me honour upon Pharaoh, and upon all his <u>host</u>, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I have gotten me <u>honour</u> upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.
