20. David Had Victories at Keilah

1 Samuel 23:1-14 KJV

Then they told David, saying, Behold, the Philistines fight against <u>Keilah</u>, and they rob the <u>threshingfloors</u>.

Therefore David <u>enquired</u> of the LORD, saying, Shall I go and <u>smite</u> these Philistines? And the LORD said unto David, Go, and smite the Philistines, and save Keilah.

And David's men said unto him, Behold, we be <u>afraid</u> here in <u>Judah</u>: how much more then if we come to Keilah against the armies of the Philistines?

Then David enquired of the LORD yet <u>again</u>. And the LORD answered him and said, Arise, go down to Keilah; for I will <u>deliver</u> the Philistines into <u>thine</u> hand. Then David and his men, which were about <u>six hundred</u>, arose and departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was <u>escaped</u> from Keilah; and he <u>forbare</u> to go forth.

And David abode in the wilderness in strong holds, and remained in a <u>mountain</u> in the wilderness of <u>Ziph</u>. And Saul sought him every day, but God delivered him not into his hand.
