22. God Delivered Sisera to a Woman

Josahu 4:1-24 NIV

After <u>Ehud</u> died, the Israelites once again did evil in the eyes of the LORD. So the LORD sold them into the hands of Jabin, a king of Canaan ... in <u>Hazor</u>. The commander of his army was <u>Sisera</u> ... he had <u>nine</u> hundred iron chariots and had <u>cruelly</u> oppressed the Israelites for twenty years, they cried to the LORD for help.

<u>Deborah</u>, a prophetess, the wife of Lappidoth, was leading Israel ... <u>held</u> court under the <u>Palm</u> ... between <u>Ramah</u> and <u>Bethel</u> in the hill country of Ephraim, and the Israelites came to her to have their <u>disputes</u> decided. She sent for <u>Barak</u> son of Abinoam ... The LORD, the God of Israel, commands you: 'Go, take with you ten thousand men of Naphtali and Zebulun ... to <u>Mount Tabor</u>. I will lure Sisera with his chariots ... troops to the <u>Kishon River</u> and give him into your hands.'"

Barak said ... "If you go ... I will go; but if you don't go with me, I won't go." "Very well," Deborah said, "I will go ... But because of the way you are going about this, the <u>honor</u> will not be <u>yours</u>, for the LORD will hand Sisera over to a woman." ...

Now Heber the Kenite had left the other <u>Kenites</u>, the descendants of Hobab, Moses' brother-in-law, and pitched his tent by the great <u>tree</u> in Zaanannim near Kedesh. When they told Sisera that Barak son of Abinoam had gone up to Mount Tabor, Sisera gathered together his nine hundred iron chariots and all the men ...

Then Deborah said to Barak, "Go! This is the day the LORD has given Sisera into your hands. Has not the LORD gone ahead of you?" So Barak went down Mount Tabor, followed by ten thousand men. At Barak's <u>advance</u>, the LORD <u>routed</u> Sisera and all his chariots and army by the sword , and Sisera abandoned his chariot and fled on foot. But Barak pursued the chariots and army as far as Harosheth Haggoyim. All the troops of Sisera fell by the sword; not a man was left.

Sisera ... fled on foot to the tent of $\underline{\text{Jael}}$, the wife of Heber the Kenite ... $\underline{\text{Jael}}$ went out to meet Sisera and said to him, "Come, my Lord , come right in. Don't be afraid." So he entered her tent, and she put a covering over him.

"I'm thirsty," he said. "Please give me some water." She opened a skin of <u>milk</u>, gave him a drink, and covered him up. "Stand in the <u>doorway</u> of the <u>tent</u>," he told her. "If someone comes by and asks you, 'Is anyone here?' say 'No.""

... Jael, Heber's wife, picked up a tent <u>peg</u> and a <u>hammer</u> and ... while he lay fast asleep ... She drove the peg through his temple into the ground, and he died.

Barak came by in <u>pursuit</u> of Sisera, and Jael went out to meet him. "Come," she said, "I will show you the man you're looking for." So he went in with her, and there lay Sisera with the tent peg through his temple-dead.

On that day God subdued Jabin, the Canaanite king, before the Israelites. And the hand of the Israelites grew stronger and stronger against <u>Jabin</u>, the Canaanite king, until they destroyed him.
