## 23. Ethiopian Eunuch Was Saved

## Acts 26-40 AMP

But an angel of the Lord said to <u>Philip</u>, Rise and proceed southward or at <u>midday</u> on the road that <u>runs</u> from Jerusalem down to <u>Gaza</u>. This is the desert [route]. So he got up and went. And behold, an <u>Ethiopian</u>, a <u>eunuch</u> of great authority under <u>Candace</u> the <u>queen</u> of the Ethiopians, who was in <u>charge</u> of all her treasure, had come to Jerusalem to worship ... [now] returning, and sitting in his chariot he was reading the book of the prophet <u>Isaiah</u>. Then the [Holy] Spirit said to Philip, Go <u>forward</u> and join yourself to this chariot.

Accordingly Philip, running up to him, heard [the man] reading the prophet Isaiah and asked, Do you really understand what you are <u>reading</u>?

And he said, How is it possible for me to do so <u>unless</u> someone <u>explains</u> it to me and <u>guides</u> me [in the right way]? And he earnestly requested Philip to come up and sit <u>beside</u> him. Now this was the <u>passage</u> of Scripture which he was reading: Like a sheep He was led to the slaughter, and as a lamb before its <u>shearer</u> is <u>dumb</u>, so He opens not His mouth.

In His humiliation He was taken away by distressing and oppressive judgment and <u>justice</u> was denied Him [caused to cease]. Who can describe or <u>relate</u> in full the wickedness of His contemporaries (generation)? For His life is taken from the earth and a <u>bloody</u> death inflicted upon Him.

And the eunuch said to Philip, I beg of you, tell me about whom does the prophet say this, about himself or about someone else? Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this <u>portion</u> of Scripture he announced to him the glad <u>tidings</u> (Gospel) of Jesus and about Him. And as they continued along on the way, they came to some water, and the eunuch exclaimed, See, [here is] water! What is to hinder my being baptized? And Philip said, If you believe with all your heart [if you have a conviction, full of <u>joyful</u> trust, that Jesus is the <u>Messiah</u> and accept Him as the Author of your salvation in the kingdom of God, giving Him your obedience, then] you may. And he replied, I do believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

And he ordered that the chariot be stopped; and both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and [Philip] baptized him.

And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord [suddenly] caught away Philip; and the eunuch saw him no more, and he <u>went</u> on his way <u>rejoicing</u>.

But Philip was found at <u>Azotus</u>, and passing on he preached the good news (Gospel) to all the towns until he reached Caesarea.
