28. Treasure in Fragile Clay Jars

2 Corinthians 4:1-13 NLT

Therefore, since God in his <u>mercy</u> has <u>given</u> us this new way, we never give up. We reject all <u>shameful</u> deeds and <u>underhanded methods</u>. We don't try to <u>trick</u> anyone or <u>distort</u> the word of God. We tell the truth before God, and all who are <u>honest</u> know this.

If the Good News we <u>preach</u> is <u>hidden</u> behind a <u>veil</u>, it is hidden only from people who are <u>perishing</u>. Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the <u>glorious light</u> of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the <u>exact</u> <u>likeness</u> of God.

You see, we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Let there be light in the darkness," has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ.

We now have this light shining in our hearts, but we ourselves are like <u>fragile clay jars</u> containing this great <u>treasure</u>. This makes it clear that our great power is from God, not from ourselves.

We are pressed on every side by <u>troubles</u>, but we are not crushed. We are <u>perplexed</u>, but not <u>driven</u> to despair. We are hunted down, but never <u>abandoned</u> by God. We get <u>knocked</u> down, but we are not destroyed. Through suffering, our bodies continue to share in the death of Jesus so that the <u>life</u> of Jesus may also be <u>seen</u> in our bodies.

Yes, we live <u>under</u> constant danger of death because we <u>serve</u> Jesus, so that the life of Jesus will be evident in our <u>dying</u> bodies. So we live in the face of death, but this has resulted in eternal life for you.

But we continue to preach because we have the same kind of faith the psalmist had when he said, "I believed in God, so I spoke."
