29. Defeat, then Victory at Ai

Joshua 7:2-5, 20-22, 25, 8:1-9 CEV

While Israel was still <u>camped</u> near Jericho, Joshua sent some <u>spies</u> with these <u>instructions</u>: " Go to the town of Ai and find out <u>whatever</u> you can about the <u>region</u> around the town." The spies left and went to Ai, which is east of Bethel and near Beth-Aven. They went back to Joshua and reported, "You don't need to send the <u>whole</u> army to attack Ai--two or three thousand <u>troops</u> will be enough. Why <u>bother</u> the whole army for a town that <u>small</u>?"

Joshua sent about three thousand soldiers to <u>attack</u> Ai. But the men of Ai fought back and chased the Israelite soldiers away from the town gate and down the hill to the stone <u>quarries</u>. Thirty-six Israelite soldiers were killed, and the Israelite army felt <u>discouraged</u>.

"It's true," Achan answered. "I sinned and <u>disobeyed</u> the LORD God of Israel. While we were in Jericho, I saw a beautiful Babylonian robe, two hundred <u>pieces</u> of silver, and a gold <u>bar</u> that <u>weighed</u> the same as fifty pieces of gold. I wanted them for <u>myself</u>, so I took them. I <u>dug</u> a <u>hole</u> under my <u>tent</u> and hid the silver, the gold, and the <u>robe</u>."

The people of Israel then stoned to death <u>Achan</u> and his family.

The LORD told Joshua:

Don't be afraid, and don't be discouraged by what happened at the town of Ai. Take the army and attack again. But first, have part of the army set up an <u>ambush</u> on the other side of the town. I will help you defeat the king of Ai and his army, and you will <u>capture</u> the town and the land around it. Destroy Ai and <u>kill</u> its king as you did at Jericho. But you may keep the livestock and everything else you want.

Joshua quickly got the army ready to attack Ai. He chose thirty thousand of his best soldiers and gave them these orders:

Tonight, while it is <u>dark</u>, <u>march</u> to Ai and take up a <u>position behind</u> the town. Get as close to the town as you can without being seen, but be ready to attack.

The rest of the army will come with me and attack near the gate. When the people of Ai come out to fight, we'll run away and let them chase us. They will think we are running from them just like the first time. But when we've let them chase us far enough away, you come out of <u>hiding</u>. The LORD our God will help you capture the town. Then set it on fire, as the LORD has told us to do. Those are your orders, now go!
