30. John the Baptist Prepared the Way

Matthew 3:1-17 NIV

In those days <u>John</u> the Baptist came, preaching in the Desert of Judea and saying, "<u>Repent</u>, for the kingdom of heaven is <u>near</u>." This is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah:

"A voice of one calling in the desert, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.' "

John's clothes were made of camel's hair, and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was <u>locusts</u> and <u>wild honey</u>. People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole <u>region</u> of the Jordan. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.

But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to where he was baptizing, he said to them: "You <u>brood</u> of <u>vipers!</u> Who warned you to flee from the coming <u>wrath?</u> Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. And do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham. The ax is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good <u>fruit</u> will be cut down and thrown into the fire.

"I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose <u>sandals</u> I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. His winnowing <u>fork</u> is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his <u>wheat</u> into the <u>barn</u> and burning up the <u>chaff</u> with <u>unquenchable fire</u>."

Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John <u>tried</u> to <u>deter</u> him, saying, "I need to be <u>baptized</u> by you, and do you come to me?"

Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is <u>proper</u> for us to do this to <u>fulfill</u> all righteousness." Then John <u>consented</u>.

As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."
