## 32. Valley of Dry Bones Became an Army

## **Ezekiel 37:1-14 KJV**

The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the <u>midst</u> of the <u>valley</u> which was full of <u>bones</u>, And caused me to pass by them <u>round</u> about: and, behold, there were very many in the <u>open</u> valley; and, lo, they were very <u>dry</u>.

And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones <u>live</u>? And I <u>answered</u>, O Lord GOD, thou knowest.

Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; Behold, I will cause <u>breath</u> to <u>enter</u> into you, and ye shall live: And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up <u>flesh</u> upon you, and cover you with <u>skin</u>, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a <u>noise</u>, and behold a <u>shaking</u>, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.

And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but there was no breath in them.

Then said he unto me, Prophesy unto the <u>wind</u>, <u>prophesy</u>, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these <u>slain</u>, that they may live.

So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and <u>stood</u> up upon their feet, an <u>exceeding great army</u>.

Then he said unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are <u>dried</u>, and our <u>hope</u> is <u>lost</u>: we are cut off for our parts.

Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, O my people, I will open your <u>graves</u>, and <u>cause</u> you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.

And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves,

And shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall <u>place</u> you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have <u>spoken</u> it, and performed it, saith the LORD.
