35. Samuel Heard and Answered God's Call

1 Samuel 3:1-14

And the child <u>Samuel ministered</u> unto the LORD before <u>Eli</u>. And the word of the LORD was <u>precious</u> in those days; there was no <u>open vision</u>. And it came to <u>pass</u> at that time, when Eli was <u>laid</u> down in his place, and his eyes began to <u>wax dim</u>, that he could not see;

And ere the <u>lamp</u> of God went out in the temple of the LORD, where the <u>ark</u> of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep;

That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I.

And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down.

And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel <u>arose</u> and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he <u>answered</u>, I called not, my son; lie down again.

Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet <u>revealed</u> unto him.

And the LORD called Samuel again the <u>third</u> time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli <u>perceived</u> that the LORD had called the child.

Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy <u>servant heareth</u>. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth. And the LORD said to Samuel, Behold, I will do a thing in Israel, at which both the ears of every one that heareth it shall <u>tingle</u>.

In that day I will <u>perform</u> against Eli all things which I have spoken <u>concerning</u> his <u>house</u>: when I begin, I will also make an end.

For I have told him that I will judge his house for ever for the <u>iniquity</u> which he knoweth; because his sons made themselves <u>vile</u>, and he restrained them not.

And therefore I have <u>sworn</u> unto the house of Eli, that the iniquity of Eli's house shall not be <u>purged</u> with <u>sacrifice</u> nor <u>offering</u> for ever.
