36. David Brought Ark of God to Jerusalem

2 Samuel 6:1-18 NIV

David again brought together out of Israel chosen men, thirty thousand in all. He and all his men set out from <u>Baalah</u> of <u>Judah</u> to bring up from there the ark of God, which is called by the <u>Name</u>, the name of the LORD Almighty, who is <u>enthroned</u> between the <u>cherubim</u> that are on the ark. They set the ark of God on a new cart and brought it from the house of <u>Abinadab</u>, which was on the hill. Uzzah and Ahio, sons of Abinadab, were guiding the new <u>cart</u> with the ark of God on it, and Ahio was <u>walking</u> in front of it. David and the whole house of Israel were <u>celebrating</u> with all their might before the LORD, with songs and with harps, <u>lyres</u>, <u>tambourines</u>, <u>sistrums</u> and <u>cymbals</u>.

When they came to the <u>threshing</u> floor of Nacon, Uzzah reached out and took hold of the ark of God, because the oxen <u>stumbled</u>. The LORD's anger burned against Uzzah because of his <u>irreverent act</u>; therefore God struck him down and he <u>died</u> there beside the ark of God.

Then David was angry because the LORD's wrath had broken out against Uzzah, and to this day that place is called <u>Perez</u> Uzzah.

David was afraid of the LORD that day and said, "How can the ark of the LORD ever come to me?" He was not willing to take the ark of the LORD to be with him in the City of David. <u>Instead</u>, he took it aside to the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite. The ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite for three months, and the LORD blessed him and his <u>entire</u> household.

Now King David was told, "The LORD has blessed the household of Obed-Edom and everything he has, because of the ark of God." So David went down and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with rejoicing. When those who were carrying the ark of the LORD had taken six <u>steps</u>, he sacrificed a bull and a <u>fattened calf</u>. David, wearing a <u>linen</u> <u>ephod</u>, <u>danced</u> before the LORD with all his might, while he and the entire house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouts and the sound of trumpets.

As the ark of the LORD was entering the City of David, Michal daughter of Saul <u>watched</u> from a <u>window</u>. And when she saw King David leaping and dancing before the LORD, she <u>despised</u> him in her heart.

They brought the ark of the LORD and set it in its place inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and David sacrificed burnt offerings and fellowship offerings before the LORD. After he had finished sacrificing the burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD Almighty.
