4. The Day of Pentecost

Acts 1:4-9 KJV

And, being assembled together with them, commanded them ... not <u>depart</u> from Jerusalem, but <u>wait</u> for the <u>promise</u> of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. For John truly <u>baptized</u> with <u>water</u>; but ye shall be baptized with the <u>Holy Ghost</u> not many days hence. When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?

And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the <u>times</u> or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power. But ye shall receive <u>power</u>, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be <u>witnesses</u> unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost <u>part</u> of the <u>earth</u>.

And when he had <u>spoken</u> these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a <u>cloud</u> received him out of their <u>sight</u>.

Acts 2:1-8, 12-21 KJV

And when the day of <u>Pentecost</u> was fully come, they were all with one <u>accord</u> in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty <u>wind</u>, and it <u>filled</u> all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them <u>cloven tongues</u> like as of <u>fire</u>, and it sat upon each of them.

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? And they were all <u>amazed</u>, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this? Others mocking said, These men are full of new <u>wine</u>.

But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, ... For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third <u>hour</u> of the day. But this is that which was spoken by the prophet <u>Joel</u>; And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will <u>pour</u> out of my <u>Spirit</u> upon all <u>flesh</u>: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:

The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and notable day of the Lord come: And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.
