# 40. Barren Women Conceived & Gave Birth, II

#### 1 Samuel 1:2-5, 10-11, 20KJV

And he had two wives ... this man went up out of his city <u>yearly</u> to <u>worship</u> and to <u>sacrifice</u> unto the LORD ... he gave to Peninnah his wife, and to all her sons and her daughters, portions ... unto Hannah he gave a worthy <u>portion</u>; for he loved <u>Hannah</u>: but the LORD had shut up her womb ... she was in <u>bitterness</u> of <u>soul</u>, and <u>prayed</u> unto the LORD, and wept sore. And she vowed a <u>vow</u>, and said, O LORD of hosts, if thou wilt indeed look on the affliction of thine handmaid, and remember me, and not forget thine handmaid, but wilt give unto thine <u>handmaid</u> a man child, then I will give him unto the LORD all the days of his life, and there shall no <u>razor</u> come upon his head.

Wherefore it came to pass, when the <u>time</u> was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and called his name Samuel ...

### 2 Kings 4:8, 16-17 CEV

... Elisha passed to <u>Shunem</u>, where was a <u>great</u> woman ... <u>Elisha</u> said to her, "Next year at this time, you'll be <u>holding</u> your own baby son in your arms."

"You're a man of God," the <u>woman</u> replied. "Please don't lie to me."
