2 Chronicles 20:1-29 KJV

... <u>Moab</u> ... <u>Ammon</u>, and .. the Ammonites, came against Jehoshaphat ... from beyond the sea on this side <u>Syria</u> ... Jehoshaphat feared, and <u>set</u> himself to <u>seek</u> the LORD, and proclaimed a <u>fast</u> ... gathered ... to ask help of the LORD ... Jehoshaphat stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court ... O LORD God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? and rulest not thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand is there not power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee? Art not thou our God, who didst drive out the inhabitants of this land before thy people Israel, and gavest it to the seed of Abraham ... have built thee a sanctuary therein for thy name, saying, If, when evil cometh upon us, as the sword, judgment, or <u>pestilence</u>, or famine, we stand before this house, and in thy presence ... cry unto thee in our <u>affliction</u>, then thou wilt hear and help ... behold ... Ammon ... Moab and mount <u>Seir</u> ... thou wouldest not let Israel invade, when they came out ... Egypt ... how they reward us ... O our God, wilt thou not judge them ... we have no might against this great company ... neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee ...

... upon Jahaziel ... came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation ... Hearken ye ... Thus saith the LORD ... Be not afraid nor <u>dismayed</u> by <u>reason</u> of this great <u>multitude</u>; for the battle is not yours, but God's. To morrow go ye down against them ... Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye <u>still</u>, and see the salvation of the LORD ... for the LORD will be with you ... Judah and the <u>inhabitants</u> of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, <u>worshipping</u> the LORD ... stood up to praise the LORD God of Israel with a <u>loud</u> voice on high.

... rose early in the <u>morning</u> ... Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me ... Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper. And when he had <u>consulted</u> with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever ... when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set <u>ambushments</u> against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir ... and they were smitten.

... Ammon and Moab stood up against ... mount Seir, utterly to slay and destroy them: and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, every one helped to <u>destroy</u> another ... they were <u>dead</u> bodies <u>fallen</u> to the earth, and none <u>escaped</u>.

... Jehoshaphat and his people came to <u>take</u> away the spoil ... they found ... <u>abundance</u> both <u>riches</u> with the dead <u>bodies</u>, and <u>precious jewels</u> ... more than they could carry away ... three days in gathering of the <u>spoil</u> ... the LORD had made them to rejoice over their enemies ... the fear of God was on all the kingdoms ... countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel.
