44. Jacob Became Israel at Bethel

Genesis 35:1-15 KJV

And God said unto Jacob, <u>Arise</u>, go up to <u>Bethel</u>, and <u>dwell</u> there: and make there an <u>altar</u> unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou <u>fleddest</u> from the face of <u>Esau</u> thy brother. Then Jacob said unto his <u>household</u>, and to all that were with him, Put away the <u>strange</u> gods that are <u>among</u> you, and be <u>clean</u>, and <u>change</u> your <u>garments</u>:

And let us arise, and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went.

And they gave unto Jacob all the strange gods which were in their <u>hand</u>, and all their earrings which were in their <u>ears</u>; and Jacob hid them under the oak which was by Shechem.

And they <u>journeyed</u>: and the <u>terror</u> of God was upon the <u>cities</u> that were <u>round</u> about them, and they did not pursue after the sons of Jacob.

So Jacob came to <u>Luz</u>, which is in the land of Canaan, that is, Bethel, he and all the people that were with him.

And he built there an altar, and called the place Elbethel: because there God appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his brother.

But Deborah, Rebekah's <u>nurse</u> died, and she was <u>buried</u> beneath Bethel under an oak: and the name of it was called Allonbachuth.

And God appeared unto Jacob again, when he came out of Padanaram, and blessed him. And God said unto him, Thy name is Jacob: thy name shall not be called any more Jacob, but Israel shall be thy name: and he called his name Israel.

And God said unto him, I am God Almighty: be <u>fruitful</u> and <u>multiply</u>; a nation and a <u>company</u> of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy <u>loins</u>... the land which I gave Abraham and <u>Isaac</u>, to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give the land.

And God went up from him in the place where he talked with him.

And Jacob set up a pillar in the place where he talked with him, even a <u>pillar</u> of stone: and he <u>poured</u> a drink offering thereon, and he poured oil thereon.

And Jacob called ... the place where God spake with him, Bethel.
